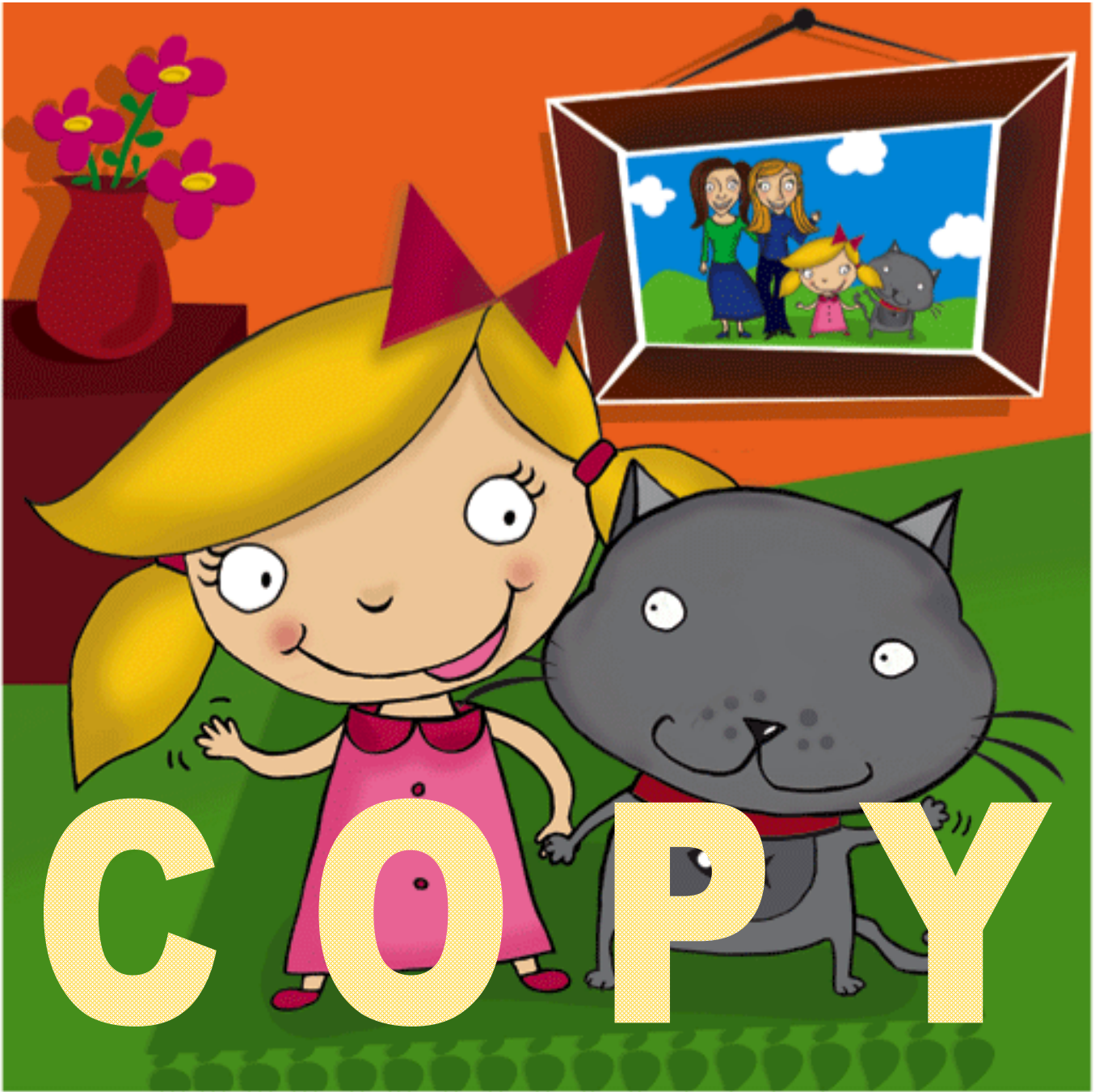
For my son, Morgan.... not in the book, but always in my heart.

Mommy.

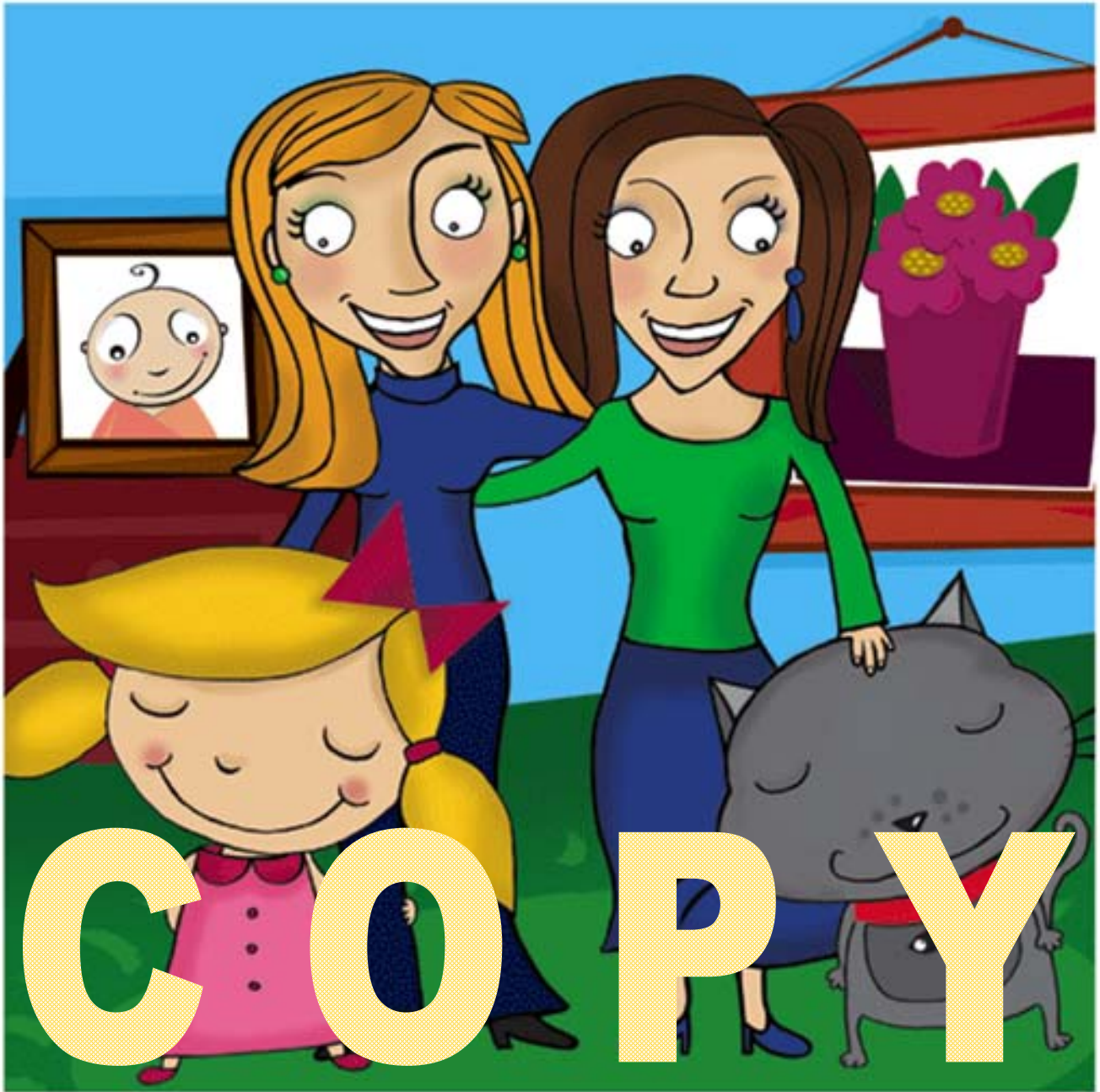
That makes two.





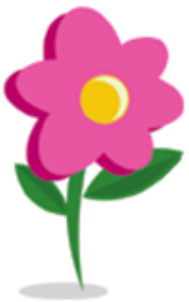
Turn the

“EMMA, THAT WAS NICE!”



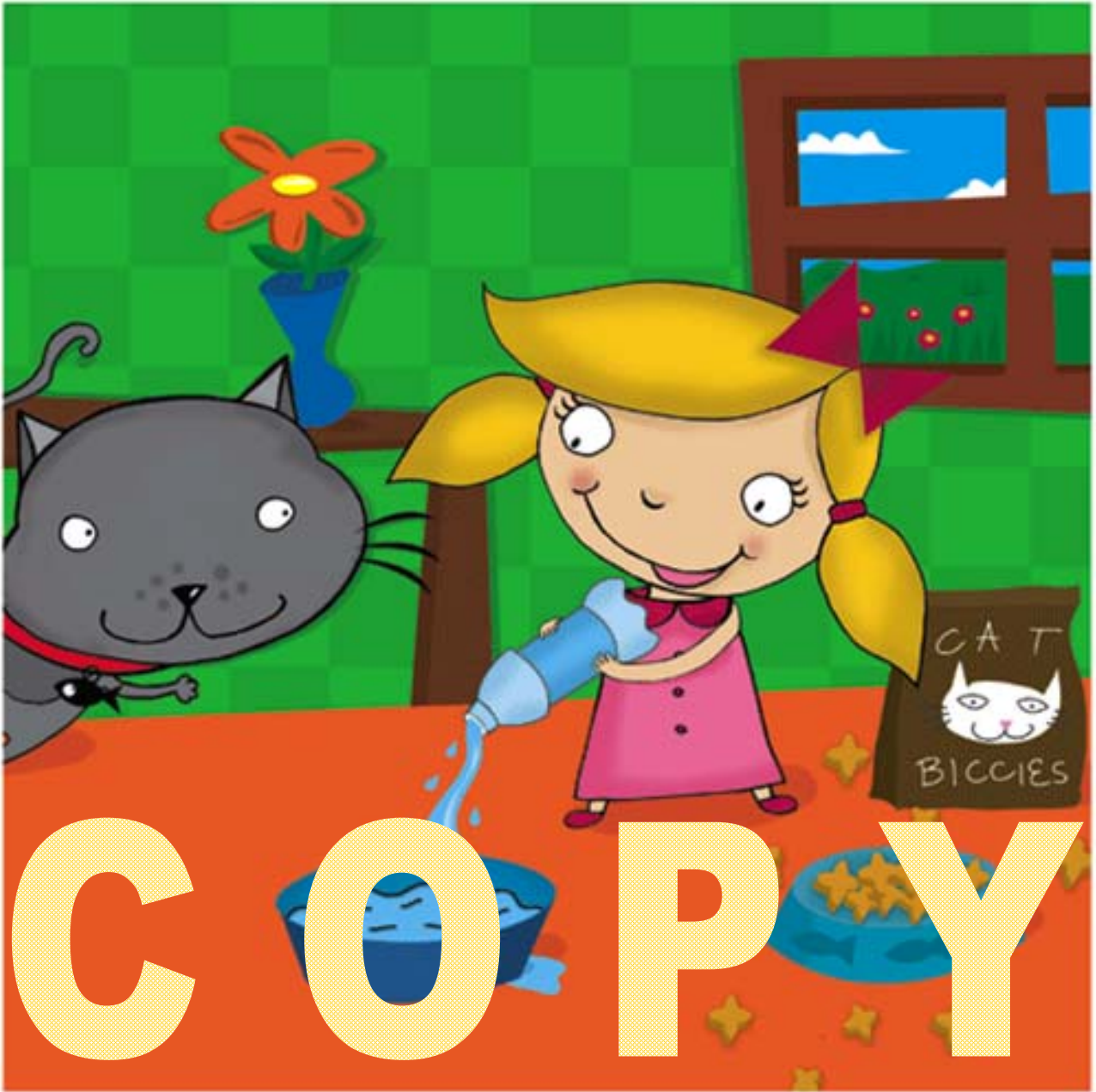


They tell her to be sweet

if you're kind to him,

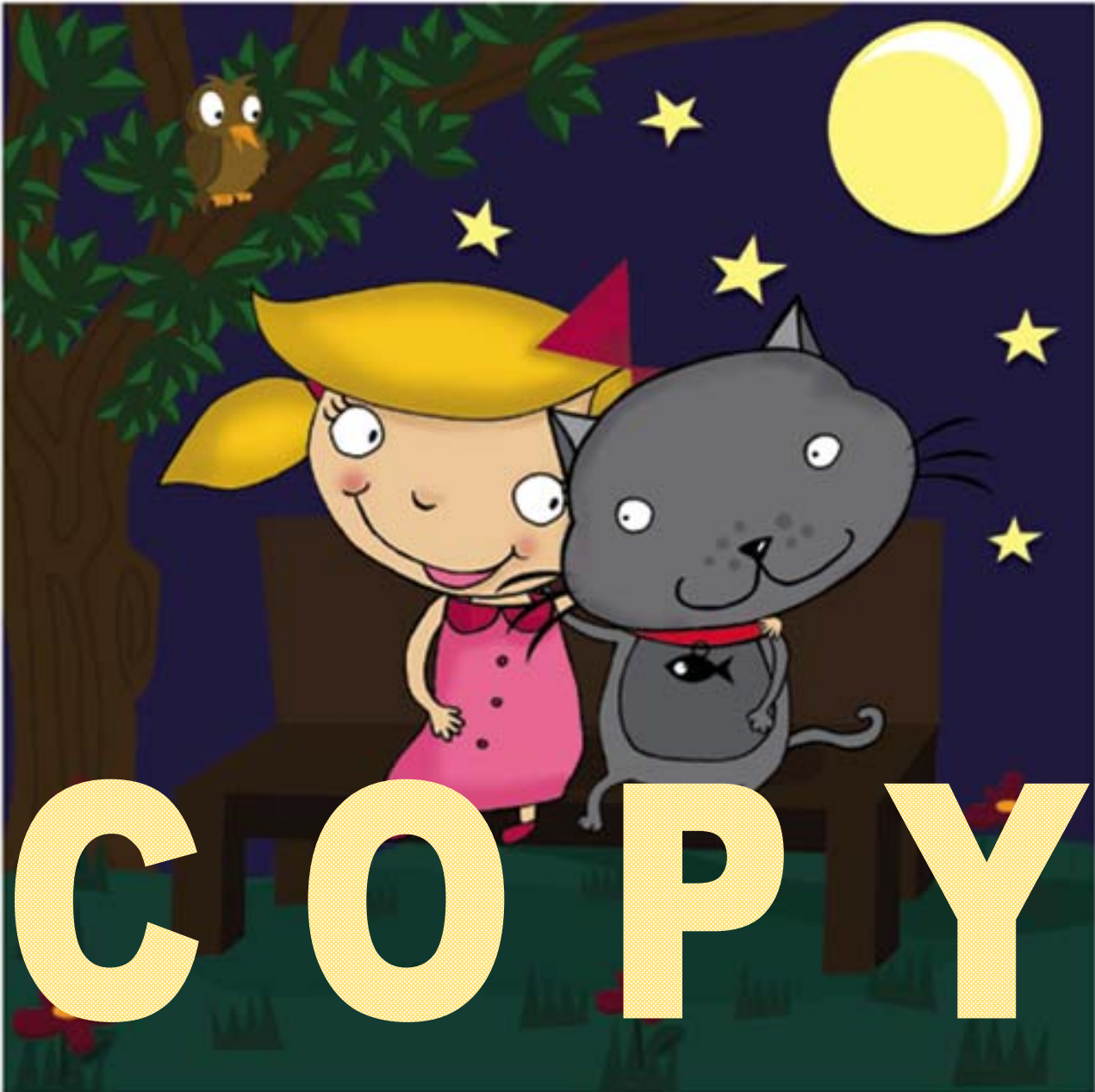
You'll hear his
